

AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF GEORGIA
AND
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF PERU
ON VISA EXEMPTION OF TOURIST/ORDINARY VISAS
FOR HOLDERS OF ORDINARY PASSPORTS

The Government of GEORGIA

And

The Government of the REPUBLIC OF PERU

Hereinafter, the "Parties";

CONSIDERING the interest of both countries of strengthening their relations of friendship and cooperation;

DESIRING to facilitate travel of nationals of any of Georgia and the Republic of Peru, who are holders of valid ordinary passports;

HAVE AGREED as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Nationals of any of Georgia and the Republic of Peru, who are holders of valid ordinary passports, shall have the right to enter into, transit through, leave and stay in the territory of the other State, without a visa, not exceeding ninety (90) days in any one hundred and eighty (180) days period.

ARTICLE 2

Nationals of Georgia and the Republic of Peru, who intend to remain in the territory of the other State for a period exceeding ninety (90) days, shall be required to obtain the corresponding visa in advance.



ARTICLE 3

Nationals mentioned in this Agreement may enter, transit and leave the territory of the other State through the border crossings open to international passenger traffic.

ARTICLE 4

Nationals of any of Georgia and the Republic of Peru during the period of their stay in the territory of the other State shall comply with the national legislation of that State.

ARTICLE 5

This Agreement shall not affect the right of Georgia and the Republic of Peru to deny entry into its territory or to shorten the permanence of the nationals of the other State, for reasons based on its national legislation.

ARTICLE 6

1. The Parties, through diplomatic channels, shall exchange specimens of their valid ordinary passports, when making the notifications referred to in paragraph 1 of article 9 of this Agreement.
2. The Parties, through diplomatic channels, shall exchange specimens of their new or modified passports with each other, together with the description of these documents, at least thirty (30) days before their entry into force.

ARTICLE 7

1. Each Party may suspend the application of the Agreement, completely or in part, in consideration of State security, public safety, public order or the protection of public health.
2. The suspension of this Agreement and the subsequent revocation of this suspension shall be notified immediately to the other Party through diplomatic channels.

ARTICLE 8

Any dispute that arises between the Parties in relation to the application and interpretation of this Agreement shall be resolved between them through consultations and/or negotiations through diplomatic channels.


ARTICLE 9

1. This Agreement shall enter into force on the first day of the month following the date of receipt of the last of the written notifications, through diplomatic channels, by which the Parties inform each other of the completion of all internal procedures necessary for its entry




- into force. With such notifications, the Parties shall share the copies of their valid ordinary passports in accordance with the provisions of numeral 1 of Article 6 of this Agreement.
2. Amendments may be introduced to the Agreement upon mutual consent of the Parties and shall enter into force in accordance with the same rule established for the entry into force of this Agreement and shall be an integral part thereof.
 3. This Agreement shall remain in force for an indefinite period of time. Either Party may, at any time, denounce this Agreement by written notification to the other Party through diplomatic channels. This Agreement shall cease to have effects ninety (90) days after receipt of such notification by the other Party.

Done in New York on the 18 day of the month of September, 2023, in two original copies, each in the Georgian, Spanish and English languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
